Guidelines for SDP Member Scholarship

The SDP Member Scholarship was established to assist SDP members that are interested in developing their skills and/or increasing their knowledge of the decorative painting field via academic courses, seminars or workshops.

General Information

1. Scholarship(s) may be awarded by SDP to recipient(s) designated by the SDP Board of Directors.
2. The SDP Member Scholarship is awarded by check to:
 - a) the recipient or b) the institution or teacher
3. The maximum value of the scholarship is \$500.
4. More than one scholarship may be approved during a fiscal year if funds are available.
5. No scholarship(s) will be awarded if the Education Committee concludes that no applicant meets the specified qualifications, or if sufficient funds are not available.

Submission Guidelines

A submission will be considered complete when the following items are received in the SDP office:

1. Application for scholarship must be on the appropriate form provided by SDP and completed in its entirety.
2. Copies of seminar program, class or course description, reflecting (a) tuition/fees and (b) a description of courses for which scholarship funds will be used. (If pursuing a degree include a copy of course requirements/degree plan.)
3. A 200-word or more, essay describing personal decorative painting goals and reason for applying.
4. A total of seven copies of the application and all support documents must be postmarked by March 1, 2010.
5. A \$5 application fee payable to SDP must accompany submission.

Failure to submit all requested information and/or to follow all guidelines will result in disqualification. No exceptions will be made.

Candidate Eligibility Criteria

1. Applicant must be a SDP member in good standing and have been a member for two years prior to the date of the scholarship application deadline.
2. No member of the Education Committee or their family members may apply for the SDP Member Scholarship.
3. Applicant must use scholarship-funded education to further his/her decorative painting goals: e.g., begin teaching, improve teaching skills, product/technique demonstrating, painting to sell, pursue degree or certification.
4. Application can be submitted annually.

Selection Criteria

In selecting the scholarship recipient(s), consideration will be given to:

1. Service to SDP and/or local chapter(s)
2. Leadership positions in SDP and/or local chapter(s)
3. Service to and leadership roles (art-related) in local community, schools, church, charities, etc.
4. Decorative painting goals
5. How applicant will use education/skills to further community knowledge of decorative painting.

Awards Disbursement

1. Upon selection of recipient(s), scholarship monies will be sent in the form of a check to
 - (a) the recipient or
 - (b) the appropriate educational institution/course/teacher.
2. Upon completion of the course(s)/seminar(s) workshop(s) for which the scholarship was awarded, evidence of completion must be sent to SDP (NSTDP).
